



## **All Classical Portland to broadcast a five-part radio concert series featuring Chamber Music Northwest**

PORTLAND, OR – Premiering May 21, 2020, All Classical Portland will broadcast a five-part radio series highlighting dynamic performances from Chamber Music Northwest's past summer seasons on 89.9FM in the Portland metro area, and worldwide at [allclassical.org](http://allclassical.org).

Featuring performances and interviews, this radio series brings Chamber Music Northwest and its beloved performers to listeners locally and worldwide, in lieu of live concerts, and in tandem with Chamber Music Northwest's innovative virtual offerings planned for this summer.

The series kicks off on May 21 with works by Fauré and Glazunov and John Leszczynski's *They Might be Gods*. Episodes aired on Thursday evenings will be encored each following Sunday at 4pm PT. In addition to concert performance highlights, the series will feature interviews with musicians including longtime CMNW Artistic Director David Shifrin who shared:

This will be the first summer in over 40 years that I won't be performing .. I am glad to be able to join you on the radio through our collaboration with All Classical Portland!"*
