

Since joining All Classical Radio in 2015, Nance has led the organization through a decade of unprecedented growth and innovation. Under her stewardship, the station has seen record-breaking listenership, launched the acclaimed International Children's Arts Network (ICAN), and built a state-of-the-art headquarters in downtown Portland.

"Suzanne has transformed All Classical Radio into a world-class cultural institution," said Board Chair Elaine Durst. "Her vision, creativity, and dedication to excellence have inspired all of us, and her impact will be felt for generations."

Nance also spearheaded numerous strategic partnerships, expanded global reach through digital innovation, and championed initiatives that reflect and uplift the diverse communities of the Pacific Northwest.

"I am deeply grateful for this extraordinary chapter of my life," said Nance. "It has been an honor to lead this remarkable organization and to work alongside a phenomenal Board of Directors and our ever-inspiring Board Chair Elaine Durst. We truly have an exceptional team, and a vibrant, supportive community of listeners. While I am excited for this new chapter in Ireland, I will always carry Portland and All Classical in my heart."
